

Annual Themes

July 2015 (2 week themes)

“Frolicking Food Fun”

“Under the Big Top”

Ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls – come join us for the ‘greatest show on earth,’ featuring attempting feats of strength. We'll showcase animal trainers, balancing acts and acrobats. In addition, we'll be creating fun crafts and put on a preschool circus featuring our own students.

August 2015 (2 week themes)

“Investigation Station”

“The Storyteller”

Creative dramatics, imaginative stories and fun are all a part of this theme! The children will be hearing stories from Hans Christian Andersen as well as other famous authors and constructing costumes and props to go with them.

September 2015

October 2015

November 2015

December 2015

January 2016

Many animals sleep for long periods of time, especially during the winter months. Why do they do it? We'll find out which animals these are, what happens to them when they are sleeping and when they wake up! We'll also have our own hibernation days at school!
