Performance Anxiety

It is not unusual for preschoolers to have some performance anxiety. Please support your child by explaining exactly what will happen the night of the show. For example, "Mommy/Daddy will sit in the chair and you will sing on the stage. Then, we will take you for a treat with your friends. We are going have fun at the show together." Children find comfort when they understand their role in a new setting. Lastly, this event is meant to be fun. Please don't force your child to participate. Take the opportunity to enjoy the show together in the audience, if needed.



PRE-REGISTRATION for... SUMMER and FALL of 2019

Westminster will offer the opportunity to register for the 2019-2020 school year during the week of January 7th. Please take the time to mark your calendar for this important week. Preregistration guarantees your child's enrollment in Westminster's 2019-2020 program. Look for registration forms in your child's bucket or cubby the first week in January. Mark your first and second choices. Remember: Westminster registers families based on seniority. Confirmations will be sent out by January 19th. Registration for waiting list families begins January 22nd. After that, pre-registration will be open to the public. In order to pre-register, please include a non-refundable registration deposit with your registration forms. These deposits are for the registration and materials fees for the 2019-2020 school year which begins in July.

Please be aware of the following:

- <u>No</u> spot will be held <u>without</u> the proper deposit (s). *All* deposits and fees are **non-refundable**.
- Schedules are based on a year-long commitment. If you decide to decrease your child's schedule at any time including the summer, we will open your child's space to our waiting list students. This is to preserve each classroom's dynamic with a stable student community. Please register for a schedule that will work for your family throughout the entire school year.
 - An activity and material fee of \$350 (includes a school T-shirt, school supplies, snacks and school-sponsored field trips) for each returning students who will attend the 2019-2020 school year.
 - An activity and material fee of \$ 95 is for those Pre-K or KT students who were June graduates and will only attend the summer program July thru August. A summer T-shirt is included.
 - A \$100 for a new student fee and file processing. Siblings are considered new students. Note: Siblings will receive seniority during registration.
